

## POOH CORNER SYMPTOMATIC CHART FOR STAFF AND CHILDREN

last update: 12/14/2020

staff member/child has a new or persistent cough, shortness of breath, new loss of sense of smell/taste, fever, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, nausea/vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue, loss of appetite, worsening runny nose



one of the above

two or more of the above, then may return to Pooh Corner in either of the following two scenarios:



may return to Pooh Corner once 48 hrs fever free / 24 hrs symptom free

receives a negative COVID-19 test result and 48 hrs fever free / 24 hrs symptom free

receives a positive COVID-19 test result or chooses not to be tested, may return to Pooh Corner after 10 days of **isolation** counting from the onset of symptoms, and must be 48 hrs fever free / 24 hrs symptom free

**EXPOSURE** occurs when an individual has had close contact (within 6ft) for at least 15 minutes, irrespective of masks or PPE being worn, with a person who has COVID-19 regardless of whether the person with COVID-19 was symptomatic at the time of exposure. Exposure occurs up to 48 hours prior to the COVID-19 positive individual's onset of symptoms.

**QUARANTINE** separates and restricts the movement of people who were exposed to a contagious disease to see if they become

**ISOLATION** separates sick people with a contagious disease from people who are not sick
